



## **COMO INTERNSHIP FAQ**

- **Where can I find a listing of positions offered and the requirements for submission ?**

- **Do I need to be currently enrolled in an undergraduate degree related area to apply?**
  - Yes
- **Do I need to secure college credit for any of the Internship positions offered ?**
  - Credit is required for all Como Zoo internship positions. Credit is optional for Horticultural, Education and Marketing positions. This is noted in each position description.
- **Do Como Internships offer stipends ?**
  - No, all internships are unpaid
- **What is the time commitments for a Como's internship?**
  - Usually four months. Start and end dates can be negotiated.
- **Can I apply for more than one internship position?**
  - Select no more than two positions; note reason for selections in the Cover Letter
- **Is housing, transportation provided?**
  - Not provided
- **When are Como Intern Applications due?**
  - Applications are due by 4:00 pm the date specified in the posted information.
  - Some positions indicate '*Open Until Filled*'. If we do not receive enough qualified applications we will continue to accept applicants after the posted date.
