

Como Internship Program FAQ

- **Are any of your internships paid?**
 - All Como internships are unpaid.
- **When are applications due?**
 - Due dates are listed on each internship page. *To be considered on time your application must be in our office by 5 pm on the due date.*
- **Do I need to be enrolled in a degree seeking program and receive college credit to intern at Como?**
 - Yes, all of our internships require candidates to be enrolled in a degree seeking program and, with the exception of the Education Internship, receive institutional credit for the internship.
- **Can I apply for more than one internship?**
 - Absolutely. You are welcome to apply for multiple internships as long as you denote this on your Internship Application (page 1)
- **What are the time commitments for Como's internships?**
 - See the individual position for timelines. Some start/stop dates are negotiable within reasonable circumstances.
- **Do you provide stipends or housing?**
 - We do not provide either.
- **What does 'open until filled' mean?**
 - Should we not receive enough qualified applicants we may accept applications past the deadline. Please inquire to ask if we still have open positions if the deadline has passed.
- **My application is complete; I sent it in on time, now what?**
 - We will confirm receipt of the application; after the deadline all of the applications (with the required materials in place) will be forwarded to the hiring staff. As a rule of thumb, you will receive a status update from us within 3 weeks of the application deadline. Como staff will select candidates for interviews and follow up within 2 weeks of application deadline.
